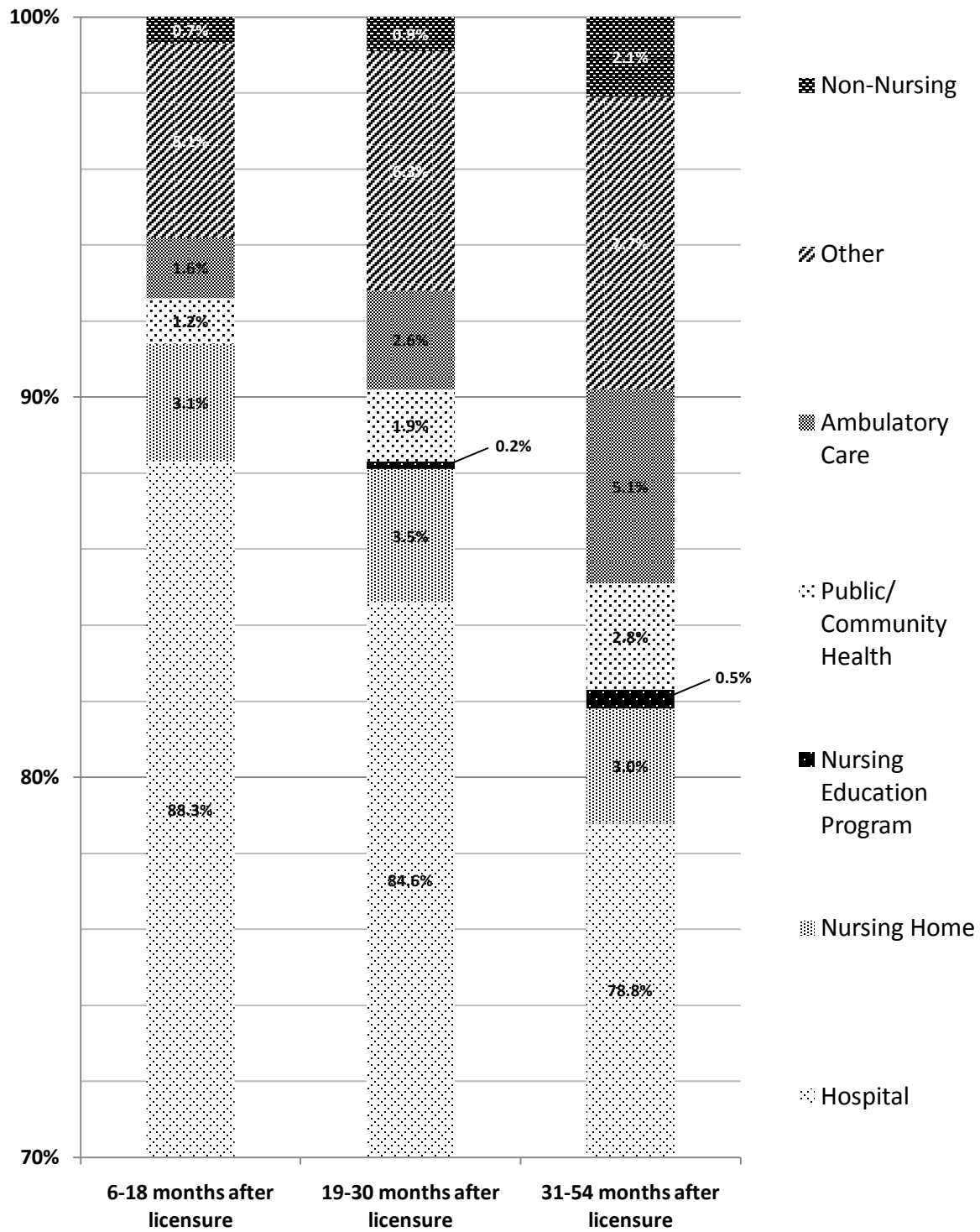


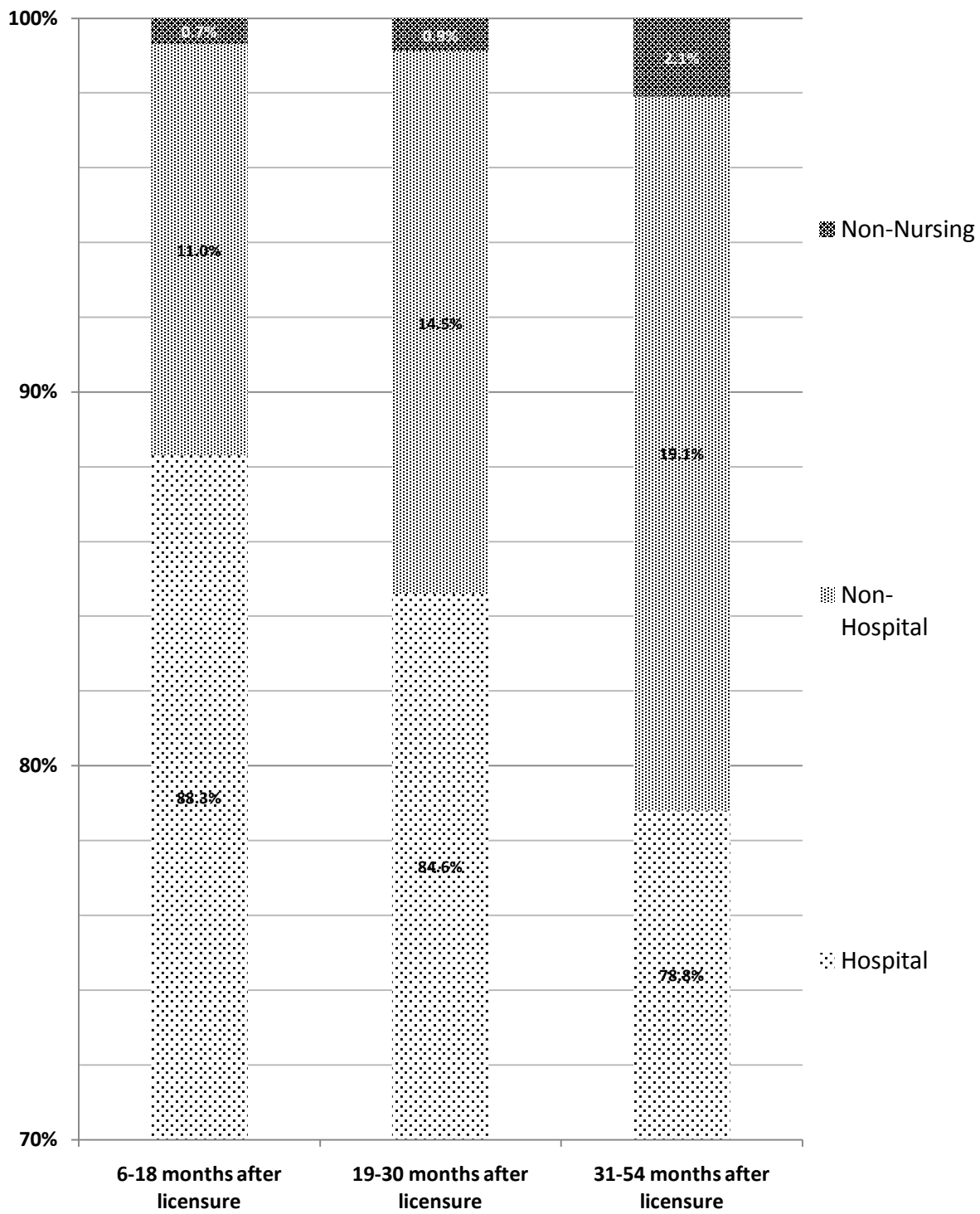
Figure 1. Work Setting of Registered Nurses in Their Early Career Years (n=1,352)

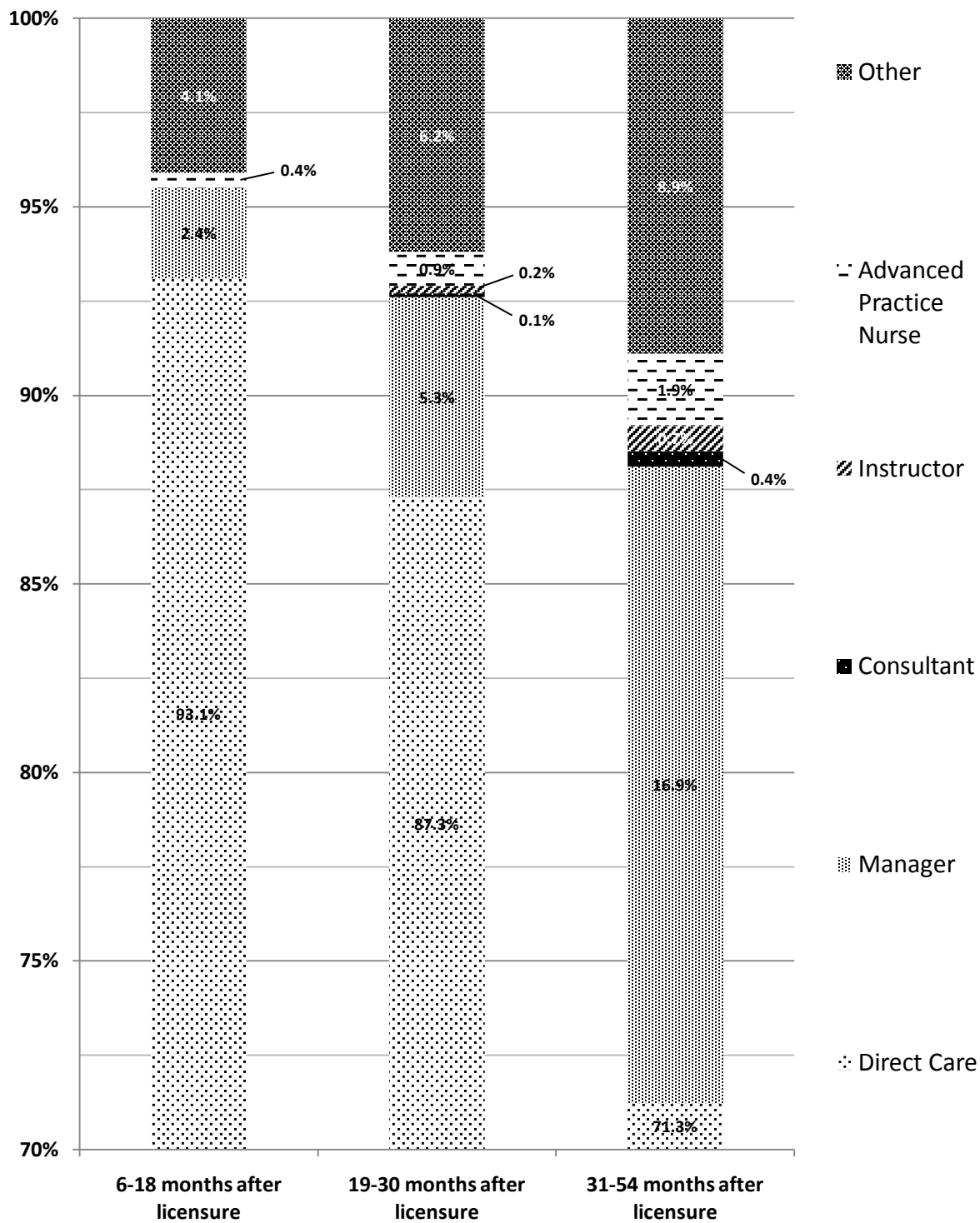
Figure 2. Work Setting of Registered Nurses in Their Early Career Years (n=1,352)

Figure 3. Job Title of Registered Nurses in Their Early Career Years (n=1,356)

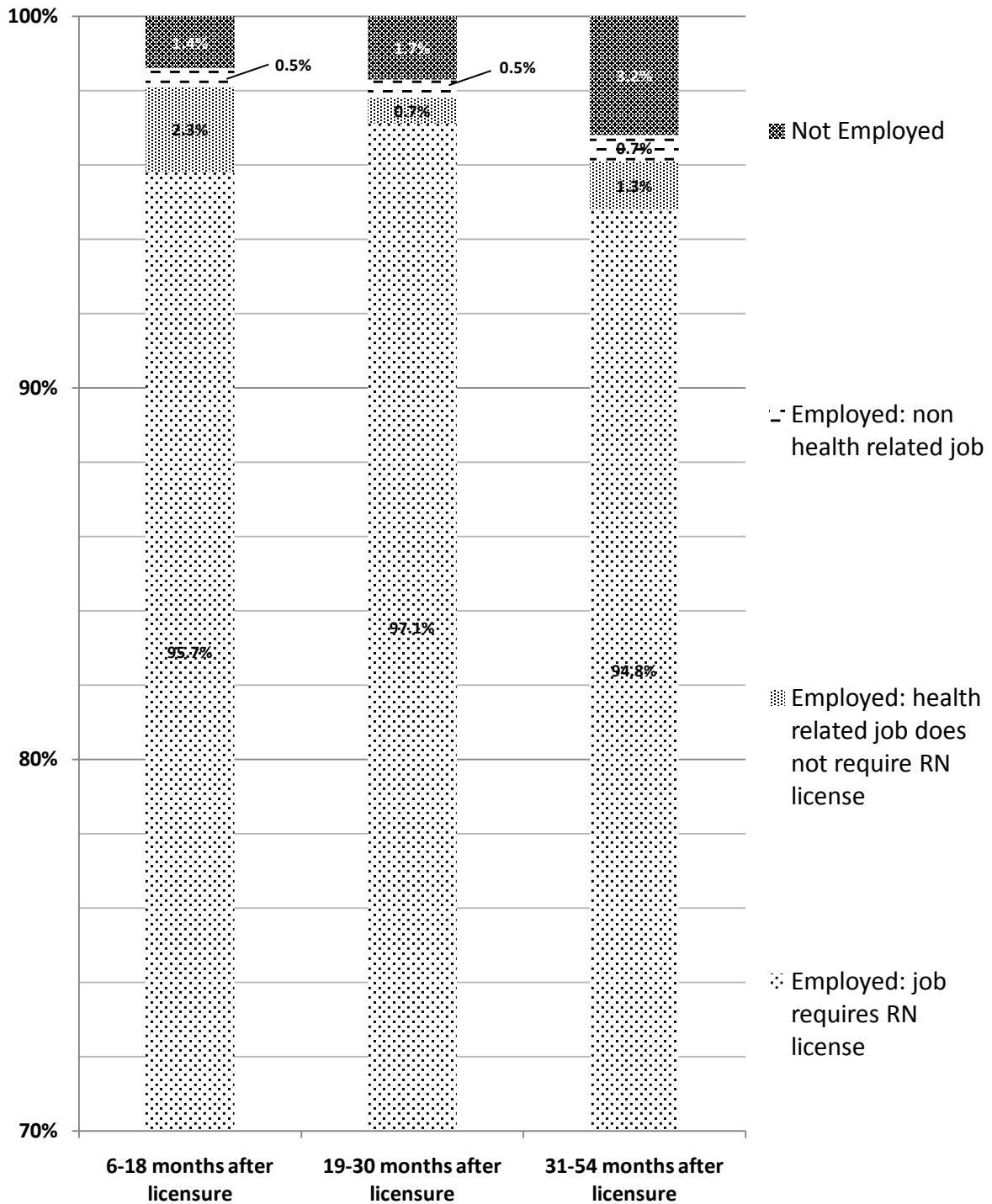

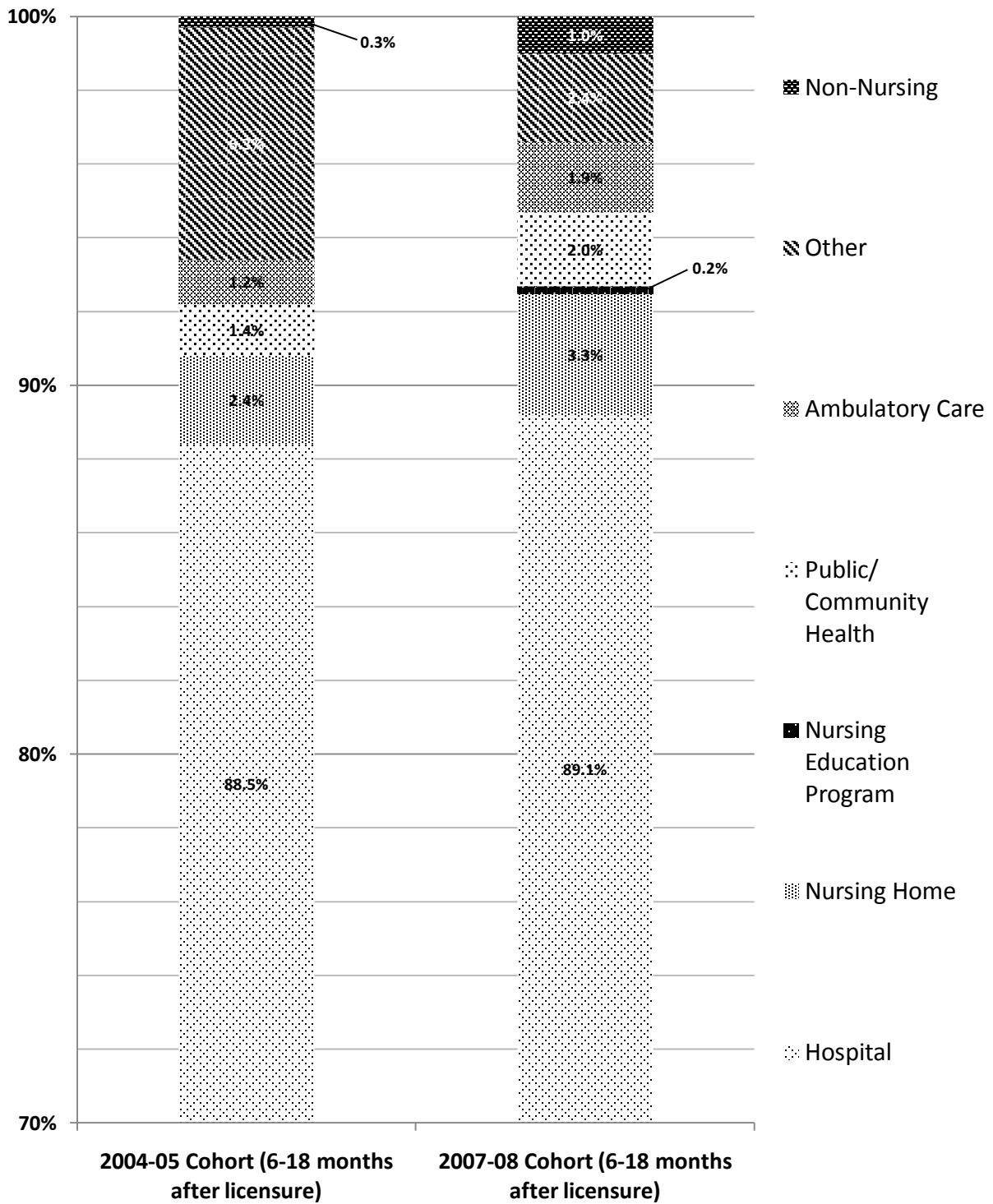
Figure 4. Employment Status of Registered Nurses in Their Early Career Years (n=1,380)



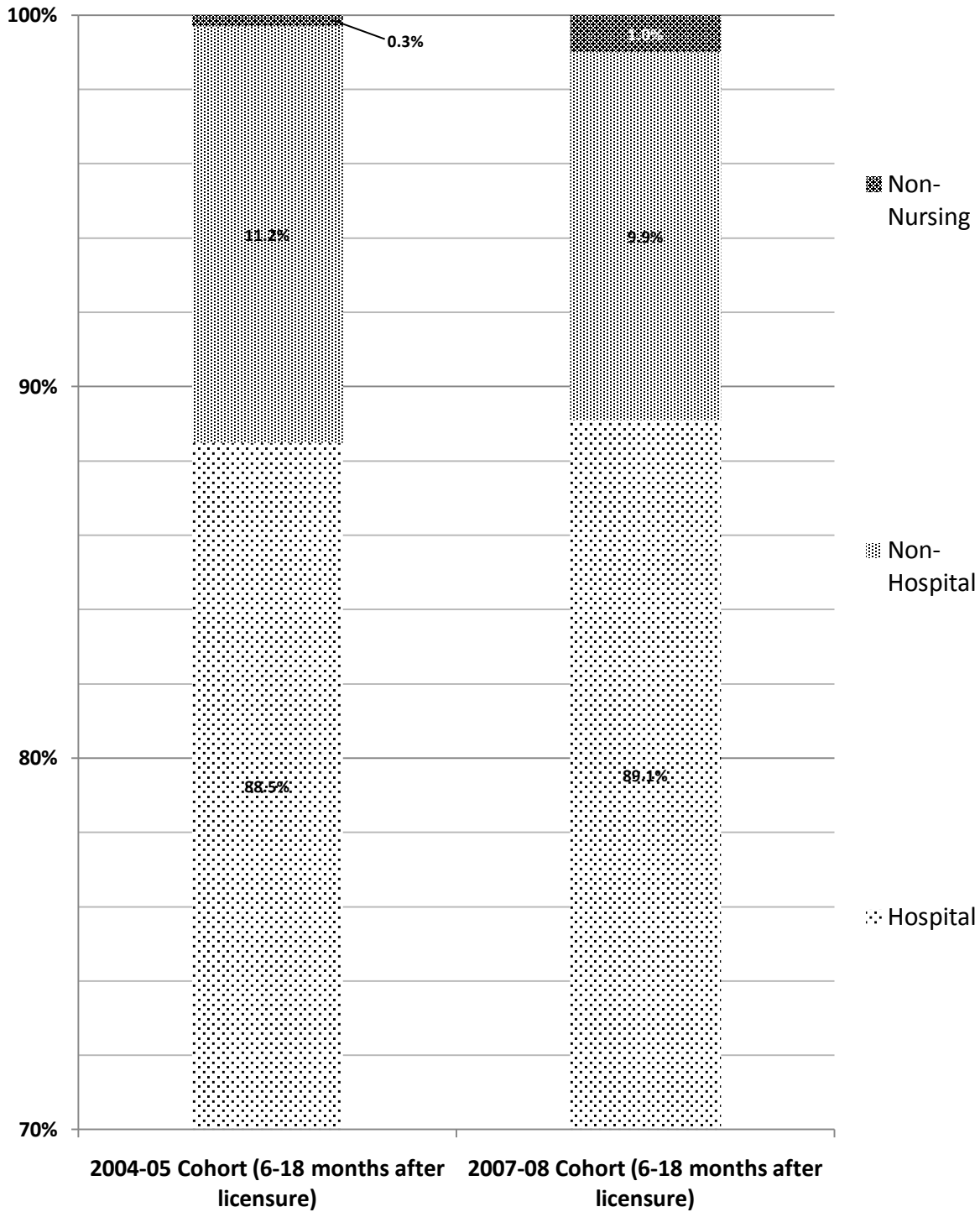

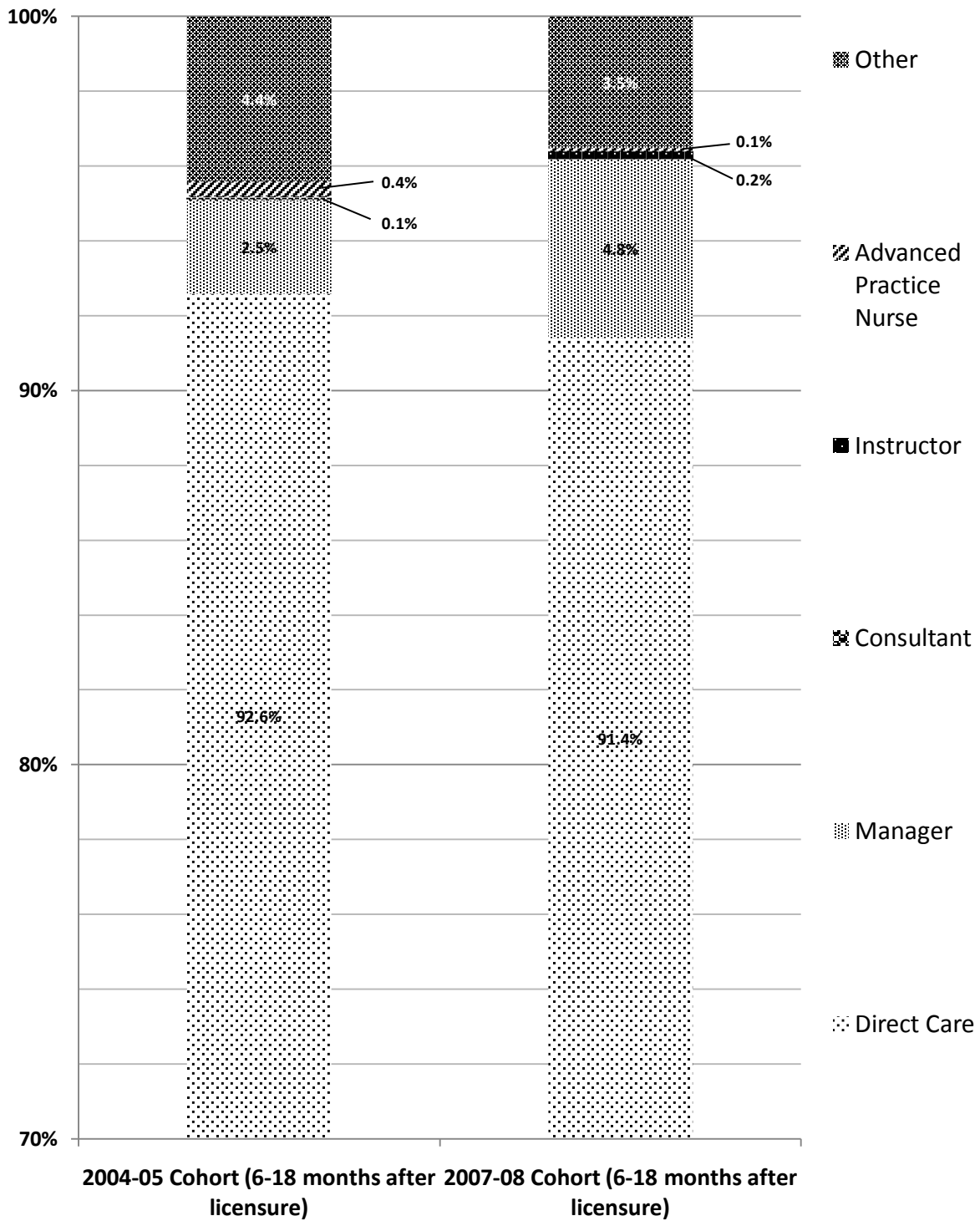
**Figure 5. Work Setting of New Registered Nurse Graduates:
