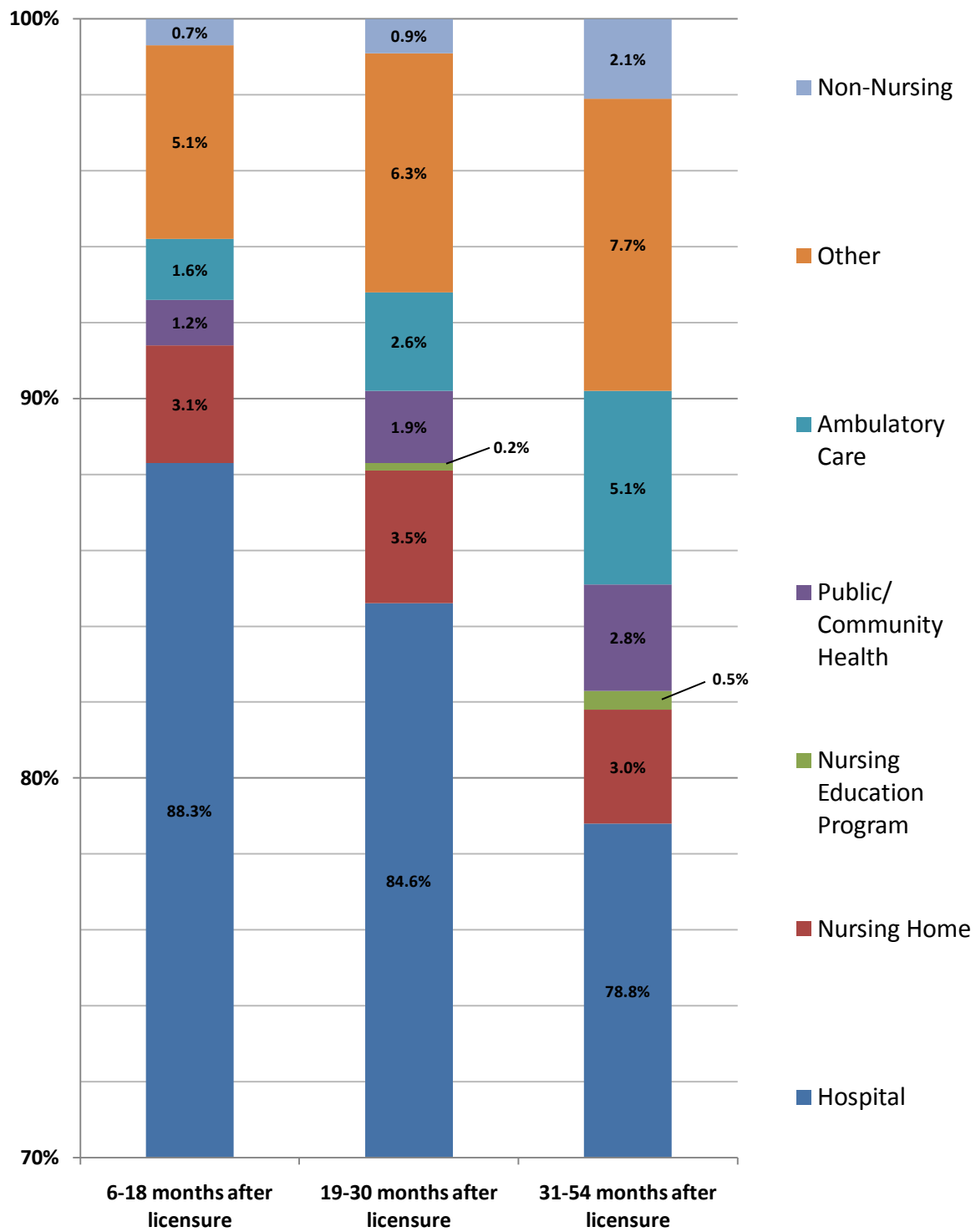


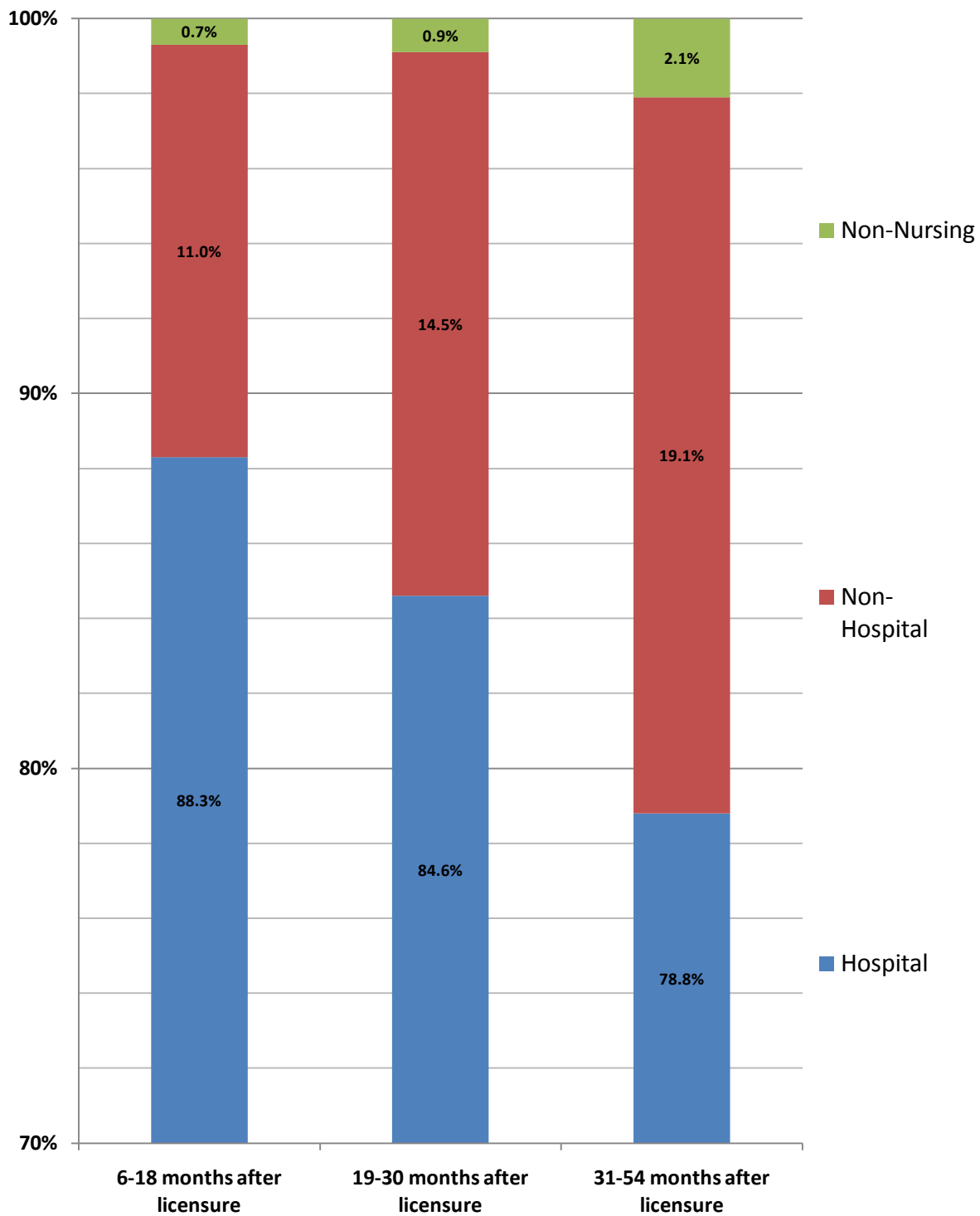
**Figure 1. Work Setting of Registered Nurses in Their Early Career Years (n=1,352)**

**Figure 2. Work Setting of Registered Nurses in Their Early Career Years (n=1,352)**

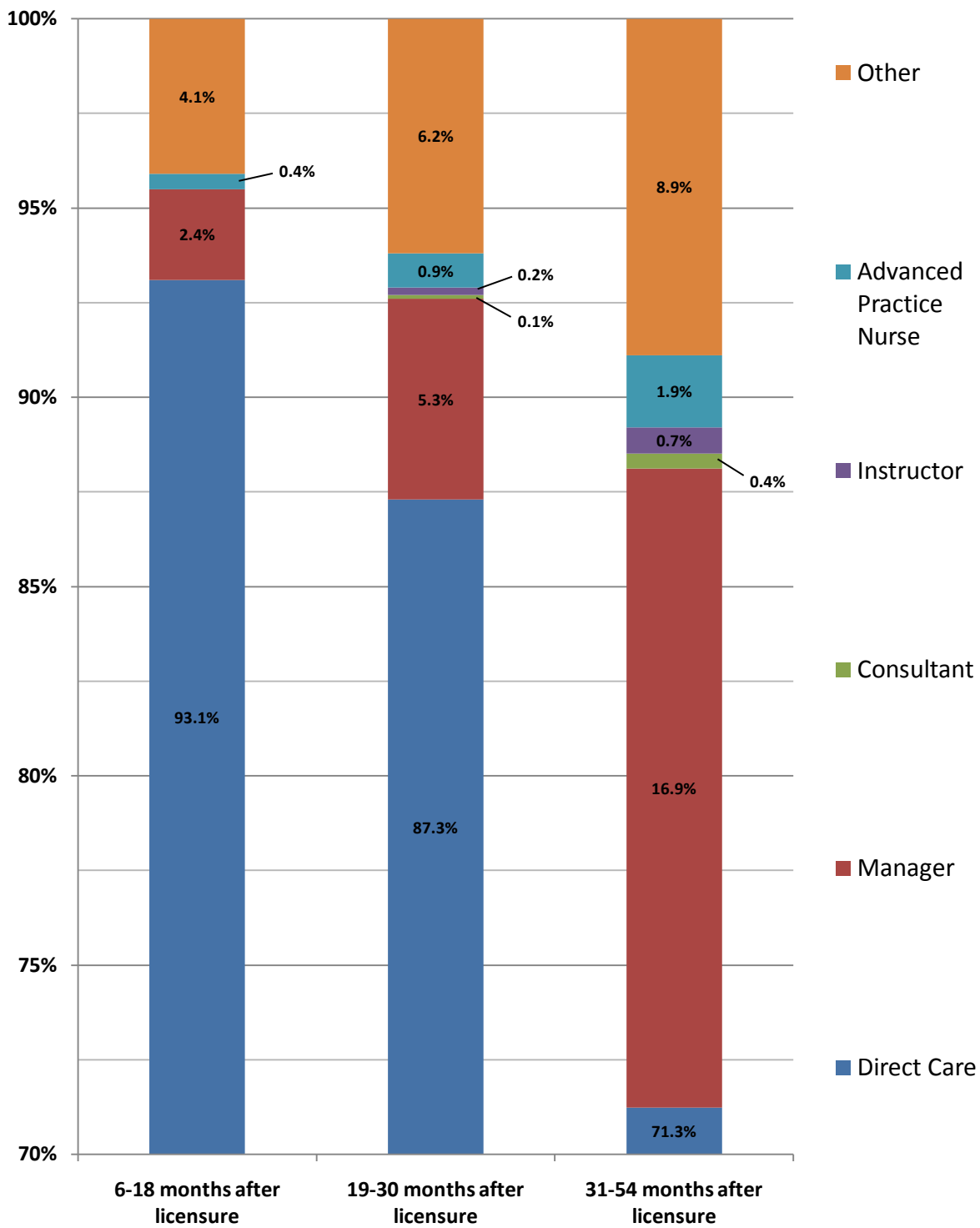

**Figure 3. Job Title of Registered Nurses in Their Early Career Years (n=1,356)**

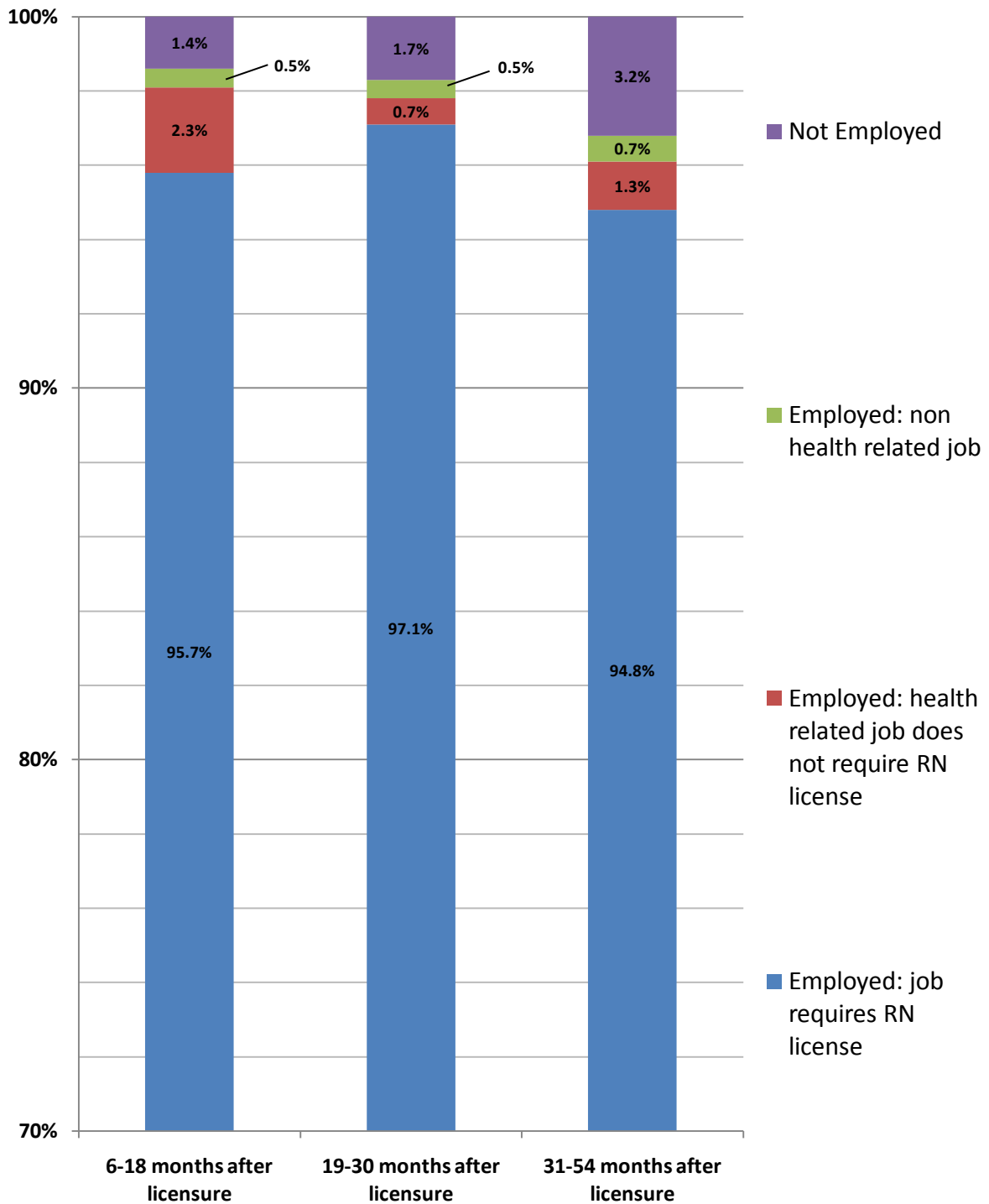

**Figure 4. Employment Status of Registered Nurses in Their Early Career Years (n=1,380)**

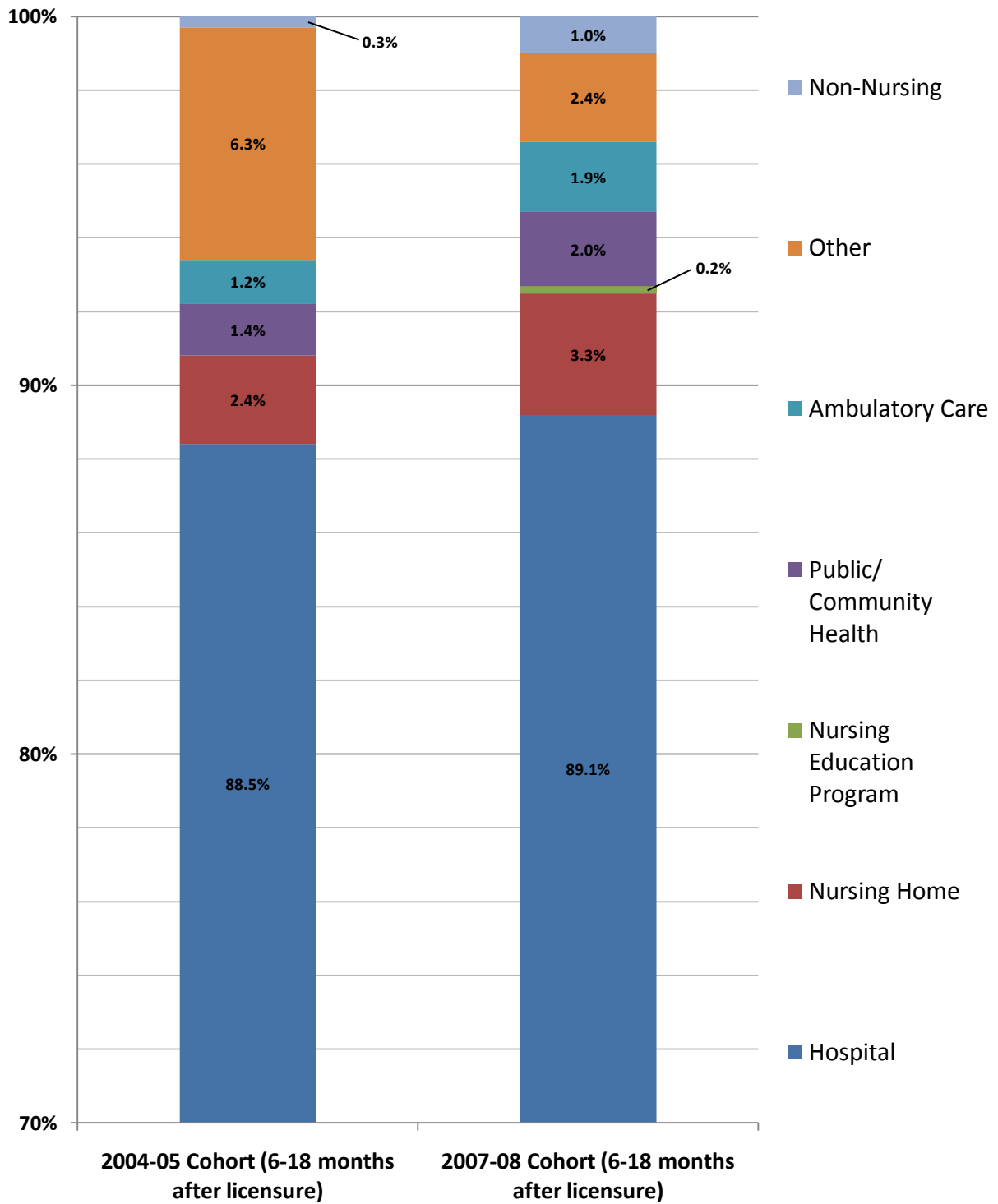

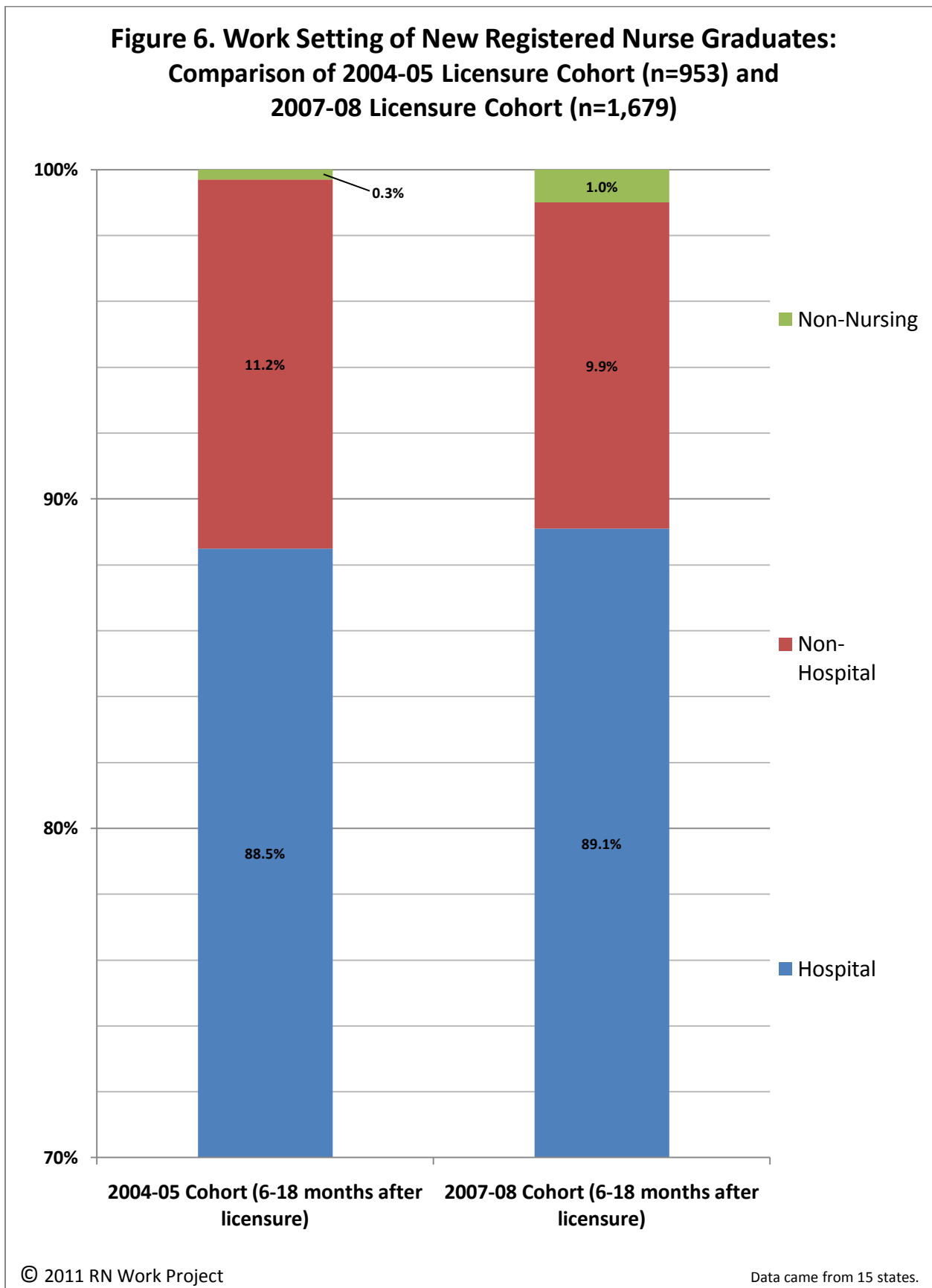

2007-08 Licensure Cohort (n=1,679)**

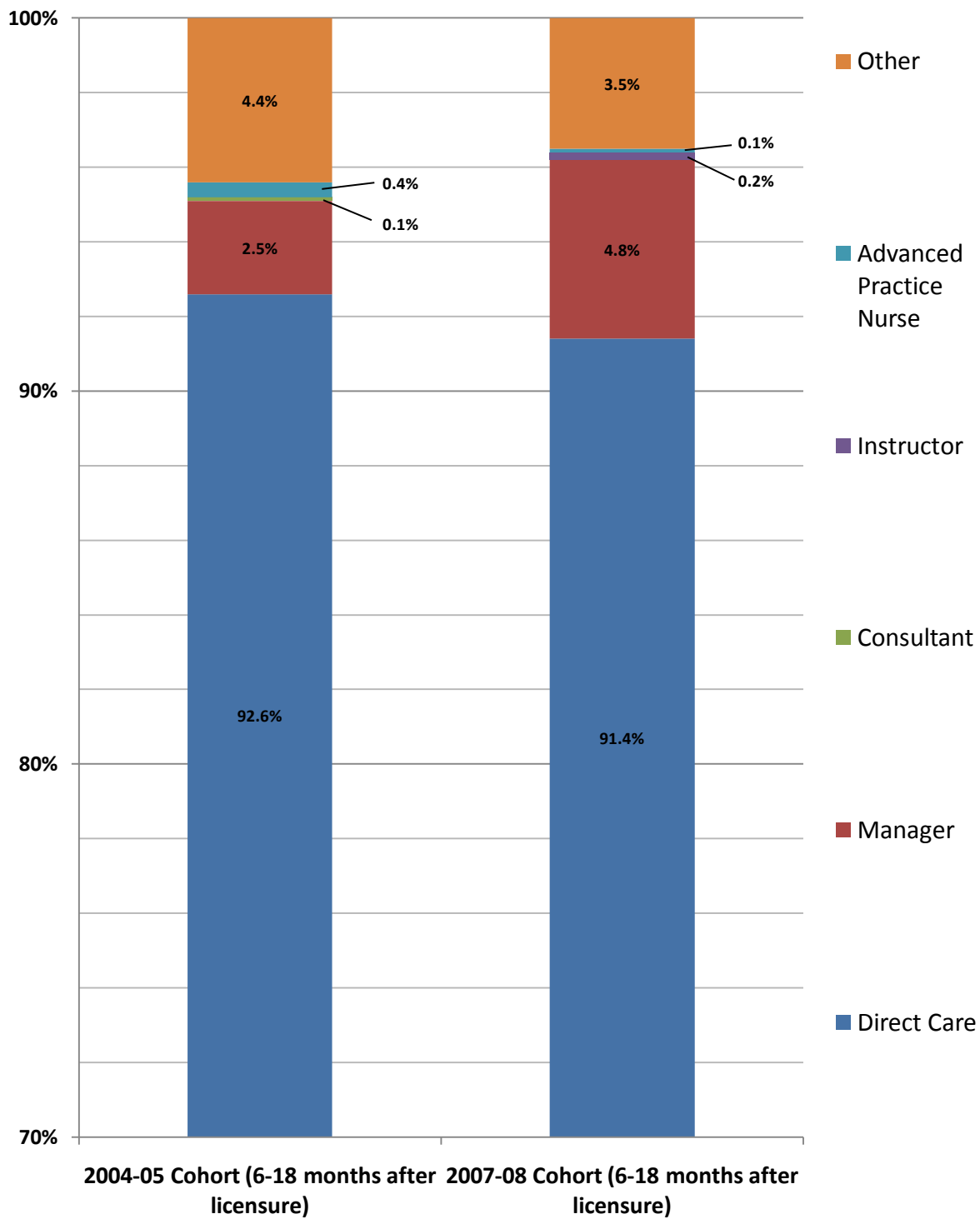

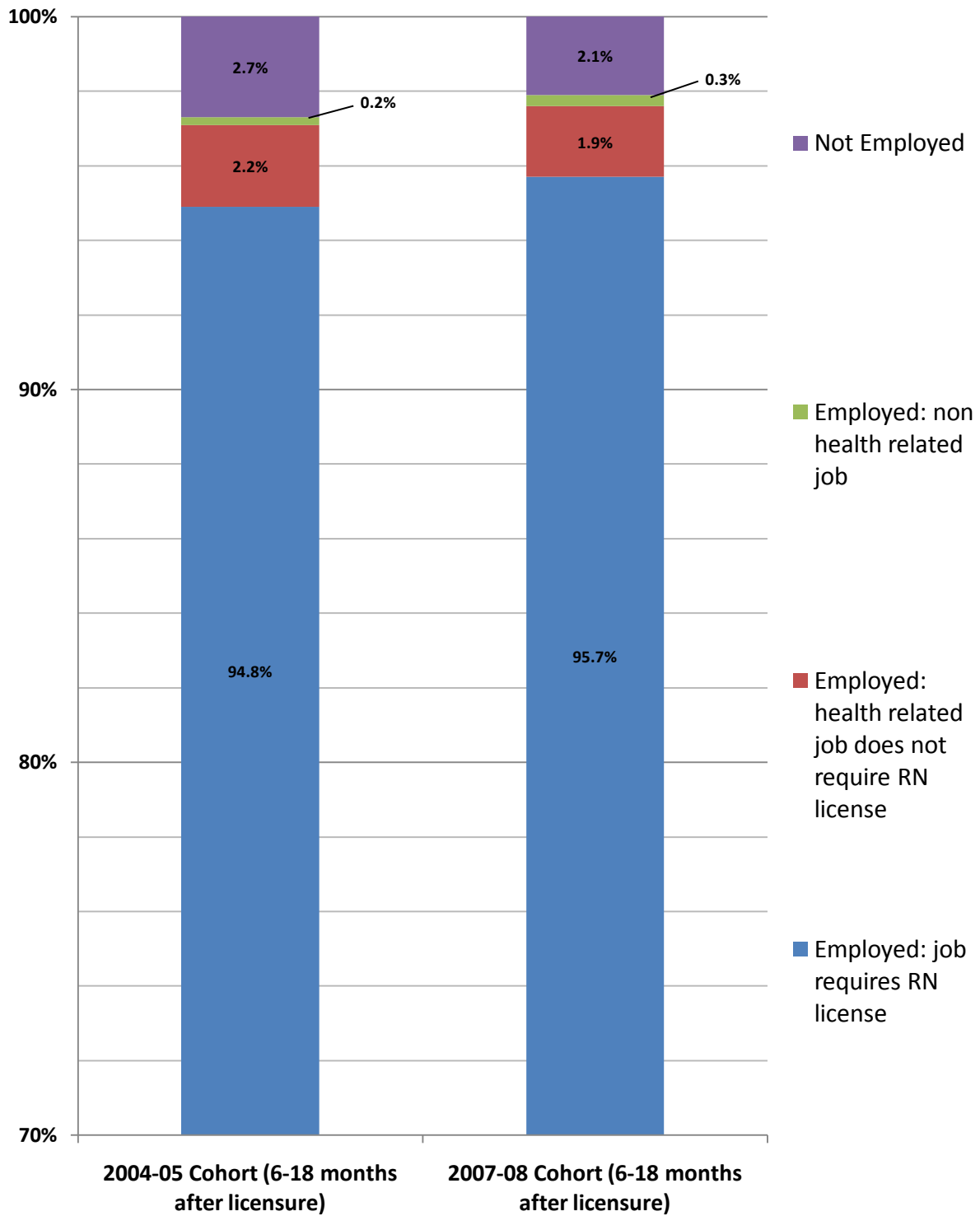


**Figure 7. Job Title of New Registered Nurse Graduates:
